


### **MAINTENANCE SAFETY**




Never service the Bobcat Excavator without instructions.




Use the correct procedure to lift and support the excavator.




Cleaning and maintenance are required daily.






✓ Vent exhaust to outside when engine must be run for service.
 ✓ Exhaust system must be tightly sealed. Exhaust fumes can kill without warning.





Lead-acid batteries produce flammable and explosive gases.



Wear eye protection to guard from battery acid, compressed springs, fluids under pressure and flying debris when engines are running or tools are used. Use eye protections approved for type of

welding.
Keep tailgate closed except for service. Close and latch tailgate before operating the excavator. lighted tobacco away from batteries.

A Batteries contain acid which

burns eyes or skin on contact.
Wear protective clothing. If acid
contacts body, flush well with
water. For eye contact flush well
and get immediate medical
attention.



Never fill fuel tank with engine running, while smoking, or when near open flame.

Maintenance procedures which are given in the Operation & Maintenance Manual can be performed by the owner/ operator without any specific technical training. Maintenance procedures which are not in the Operation & Maintenance Manual must be performed ONLY BY QUALIFIED BOBCAT SERVICE PERSONNEL. Always use genuine Bobcat replacement parts.
